School Uniform

- White short- or long-sleeved shirt or polo shirt
- Red cardigan or jumper
- Grey shorts, trousers, skirt, or pinafore (no leggings or jeggings)
- Red and white checked summer dress or playsuit
- Smart, flat black shoes (no boots, trainers or sandals)
- Grey or red tights to be worn with grey skirt or pinafore only
- Grey or white socks
- School tie (optional)
- Wrist watch (no smart watches)
- One pair of small, flat, stud earrings (must be removed for PE)



PE Kit

- Red polo shirt – Haxey logo or plain
- Plain black PE/sports shorts or cycle shorts – (no sports brand/team logo)
- Trainers/plimsolls

In cold weather, outdoor PE kit may comprise of:

- Red sweatshirt – Haxey logo or plain (no sports brand/team logos or hoodies/zip up jackets and **no** black tops)
- Plain black joggers or leggings



Earrings & PE

Earrings may **not** be worn for Physical Education, without exception. The taping of earrings is **not** a suitable substitute for removing earrings. When having ears pierced for the first time, this should be planned for the start of the 6-week summer holiday period in order to allow the necessary time before earrings can be removed. Members of staff cannot remove/put earrings back in.

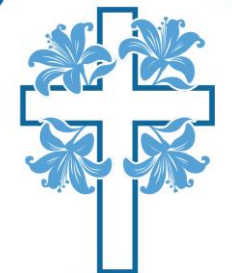
